How to submit Public Comment

Members of public may provide public comment by emailing publiccomment@ci.healdsburg.ca.us, during the public comment period on that particular item, or during the public comment period for non-agenda items. For example, public comments on Item 3A will be received from the point at which the Chair opens the public comment period on Item 3A, to the point at which he closes the comment period. We will hold the comment period open for at least three (3) minutes to ensure anyone with a comment is able to email the comment. Comments received during the relevant time period will be read into the record, with a maximum allowance of 3 minutes per individual comment, subject to the Chair's discretion. All comments should be a maximum of 500 words, which corresponds to approximately 3 minutes of speaking time. Any comment received outside of the comment period on that item, or outside of public comment on non-agendized items, including all comments received prior to the start of the meeting, will be included in the record of the meeting but will not be read into the record.
