

Supplemental CUP Application Questionnaire for Alcohol Related Uses

All applicants for alcoholic beverage use permits are required to provide additional information regarding their proposal. This information will enable City Staff and the Planning Commission to gain a more thorough understanding of the project to aid in the processing of the application. Please provide details of the project as it relates to the following items:

A. Does the project include any element of live entertainment or amplified music? Yes No

The North Village mixed use development includes a new 108-key hotel. Music contributes to the ambience of the guest experience at quality hotel destinations. Music entertainment, including prerecorded and live performance, will be enjoyed by hotel guests, North Village residents and visitors. Sound levels will comply with standards identified in the City’s noise ordinance.

B. Does the project include any special events? Yes No

If yes, please provide information on the following:

1) Describe the type of events proposed.

The hotel at North Village is anticipated to be a venue of choice for private party events, business events and community events.

2) Number of events per year.

Hotel events are held at the request of the hosts; therefore, a specific number of events is not able to be determined at this time.

3) Anticipated dates of events.

Dates for events will be determined as event reservations are requested.

4) Time of events.

Times for events will be determined as event reservations are requested.

5) Are these events public or private?

As noted, events are anticipated to be private party events, business events and community events that would be open to the public.

6) Maximum number of attendees at each event.

The number of attendees will vary according to the type of event. In no case will the maximum number of attendees exceed building and fire code occupancy limits that are in effect at the time of the event.

7) Will food be prepared on-site (if yes explain)?

The hotel includes a restaurant, rooftop bar and food and beverage service, It is anticipated that food and beverage for events will also be prepared on-site.

8) Will alcohol be sold on-site at all the events?

Refreshments, including alcoholic beverages, may be offered or be available for purchase at events.

9) What is the maximum occupancy for the event space?

Based on the current building code, the maximum occupancy of the Grange main room is 165 persons and the maximum occupancy of the junior ballroom is 84. The north patio of the Grange has a maximum occupancy of 140. The Event Lawn has a maximum occupancy of 333 based on a 5,000 square foot area.
