NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

18/19 Measure V Pavement Rehabilitation Project

The City of Healdsburg has contracted with VSS International for construction of the 2018-19 Measure V Pavement Rehabilitation Project. We anticipate that construction will begin on Tuesday, June 18, and last approximately six weeks. The project will primarily consist of roadway resurfacing of various selected streets. See the attached map of streets to be resurfaced.

Prior to the resurfacing, roadway cracks will be filled, trees will be trimmed to accommodate construction vehicles, existing striping will be removed, localized pavement failures will be repaired, and the roadways will be swept and cleaned. During these preparation activities, you will be able to use and drive on most areas of the streets, except where construction crews will be working.

Depending on location, resurfacing will include the application of asphalt-rubber chip seal followed by microsurfacing, or a microsurfacing treatment only. When complete, the street surface will be uniform, consistent, and well-sealed to protect the roadway from further infiltration of water, which is a major cause of pavement deterioration. During the placement of each application, driving and parking on your street will be prohibited by traffic control and construction-area signs.

After each of the applications has cured sufficiently, you will be able to drive on the roads the same day of work. The asphalt-rubber chip seal requires approximately 30 minutes to cure while microsurfacing requires approximately three hours. The contractor will provide additional notification 48 hours in advance of resurfacing that will detail the day and times that individual street segments will be resurfaced.

After the roadway resurfacing has been completed, roadway striping will be reinstalled.

Please always observe and adhere to construction area signage and posted parking restrictions.
