

RECAP

PARKS, RIVER ACCESS, & CONNECTIVITY

GOAL:

- Explore/develop opportunities to enhance river access and increase connectivity between City parks, the river and open spaces. Assess opportunities to enhance/increase access to bathrooms and improve City parks and open spaces.

OUTCOMES:

- Begin the process to develop a Park Master Plan at Badger Park that will focus on enhancing bathroom facilities, river access, connectivity, and other recreational opportunities that meet the community's needs.
- Explore and formulate a plan to renovate and where appropriate add public restroom facilities in city parks.
- Explore opportunities to develop pedestrian connectivity between city parks, open space properties and the river.

WHAT WE HEARD FROM THE LAST PDT MEETING:

EXISTING CONDITIONS

- Badger Park is a key community resource for walkers, senior citizens, young people, and families. It will likely be the neighborhood park for the Mill District.
- The Montage site consists of diverse topographic, hydrological, and ecological conditions. It could expand on Barbieri Brothers Park, and it will neighbor the Parkland Farms community and the Montage Resort.

OPPORTUNITIES

- At Badger Park, amplifying, adjusting, and adding park functions will be key.
- At the Montage site, there is enthusiasm for a range of program opportunities, including event space, athletics, and nature-based recreation.
- We will continue to evolve the programming of both sites with input from the PDT.

NEXT STEPS



NEXT STEPS:


- Fletcher Studio will work with the consulting team to dig into these themes / questions and bring feedback to the next PDT Montage/Badger Meeting.

HEALDSBURG CONNECTIVITY


CURRENT / PLANNED ROUTES AND DESTINATION MAP

SHARED USE PATHS (CLASS I - OFF STREET/MULTI USE)




SHARED PEDESTRIAN / CURBLESS STREETS




ROAD DIET / TRAFFIC CALMING

BIKE ROUTES (CLASS III, ONSTREET SHARROWS/WIDENED STREETS)







